
1. On the day of the test, you must bring a photo ID, 2B pencils, and erasers. The ID must be valid, original and unexpired.
2. Cell phones and all other electronic devices:
 - (1) All cell phones and electronic devices must be placed in designated areas.
 - (2) Cell phones, all other electronic devices, and alarm clock settings must be turned off. If they are not turned off during the test, it will be considered misconduct, and 2 points will be deducted from your score on that particular section of the test. If any of your electronic devices ring or vibrate, 5 points will be deducted from your score on that particular section.
3. Find your seat on the seating plan when you arrive at the test room. Admission to the test room will cease 10 minutes after the scheduled start time.
4. On entering the test room, you must present a valid photo ID. If you fail to do so, you will be allowed to take the test and subject to the following conditions:
 - (1) You must follow the invigilator to the test center office right after the test finishes and have your photo taken by a staff member of your school.
 - (2) You must bring and present your valid ID to the designated member of staff in your school within the predetermined time frame after the test.

5. Duration of CSEPT

Sections	Number of Questions	Duration
1. Listening	30	about 25 minutes
2. English Usage	50	30 minutes
3. Reading	30	35 minutes

All questions are multiple choice questions, and each question has only one correct answer. Please fill in the answer box with a black pencil on the answer sheet provided.

6. If you fail to comply with the following regulations during the test, you will receive neither a score nor a refund.
 - (1) During the test, you may not copy test questions or answers, or make marks of any kind on any materials other than the test question paper.
 - (2) You may not communicate with or copy from other test takers, or cheat in any other way.
 - (3) You must stop working immediately when time is called.
 - (4) You are not allowed to leave the test room until the invigilator dismisses you.
 - (5) If you are allowed to take the test without a valid ID, you must complete the required procedures listed in point 4.

- (6) Taking the test for someone else or allowing someone to take the test for you will result in a three-year ban from the test for all parties involved.
 - (7) The CSEPT test is copyrighted property of the LTTC. Any attempt to remove test materials from the test room or to copy the test content by taking photos, recording or any other format during the test will result in a five-year ban from the test, and your school will be notified of your misconduct.
7. There are no scheduled breaks between tests. During the test, if you need a break because of physical discomfort, you must seek permission from the invigilator. You will not be permitted to make up the time you lose.
8. You may not skip between sections. The CSEPT has three sections, Listening, English Usage, and Reading. A certain amount of time is allotted for each section. During the allotted time for each section, whether you have completed the section or not, you are not permitted to work on or make changes of any kind in the other sections.
9. If for any reason a test cannot be scored or reported, the LTTC will make appropriate arrangements, such as scheduling another test session or providing a full refund.
10. If unforeseeable events (natural disasters, strikes, demonstrations, etc.) prevent testing from proceeding as scheduled, the LTTC will announce subsequent arrangements. Please check for information on the CSEPT website or call the LTTC before the test day.
