### The Writing Test

- (1) Write your answers in blue or black ink in the designated area on the answer sheet. Do not use pencil.
- (2) You can make corrections with correction tape.
- (3) You must write your answers clearly in the designated area on the answer sheet. If you fail to do so or stain the answer sheet in a way that causes errors in the scanning process, the outcome will be the candidate's sole responsibility.

### The Speaking Test

- (1) The Speaking test is administered in a computer room. You will hear the questions through a headset and your answers will be recorded.
- (2) During the test, you must wear a headset and answer the questions as instructed. Avoid touching the recording deck on the desk during the test, as doing so may affect the recording quality.
- (3) If the test is interrupted by any incidents (technical problems, a power failure, etc.), the LTTC will reschedule the affected candidates for another test session. Affected candidates will not be given extra marks.

6. If you fail to comply with the following regulations during the test, you will receive neither a score nor a refund.
  - (1) During the test, you may not copy test questions or answers, or make marks of any kind on any materials other than the test question paper.
  - (2) You may not communicate with or copy from other test takers, or cheat in any other way.
  - (3) You must stop working immediately when time is called.
  - (4) You are not allowed to leave the test room until the invigilator dismisses you.
  - (5) If you are allowed to take the test without a valid ID, you must complete the required procedures listed in point 4.
  - (6) Taking the test for someone else or allowing someone to take the test for you will result in a three-year ban from the test for all parties involved.
  - (7) The CSEPT test is copyrighted property of the LTTC.
