

2026 Wenzao English Reading Cup

English Escape: Log out of the world. Dive into a book.

I. Purpose:

This competition aims to motivate students to improve their English skills and reading proficiency through interesting books and interactive challenges. It also encourages broad reading, builds language confidence, and fosters the habit of reading in students.

II. Organizer:

IV. Eligibility:

Students from different programs and departments at Wenzao Ursuline University of Languages are eligible to participate in the contest.

V. Reading Range:

The books provided on the Xreading Online English Book Platform

VI. Details:

1. Registration Time: Effective immediately through January 8th, 2026, at 12:00 PM.

3. Number of Participants: **Limited to 50.** (First come, first served.)
4. Contest Time: From February 1st, 2026, to March 3rd, 2026 at 23:59.

7. Online Briefing: All participants are required to attend the online briefing session, scheduled for January 9th, 2026 (Friday) at 12:10. The link to the meeting will be provided in advance.

8. Reading Process:
 - (1) On the Xreading platform, click the “Add book” button to browse and select the books you’re interested in from the Library.
 - (2) (Before the Quiz) Complete the Online Book Return: After reading a book, you must return it online before taking the quiz.
 - (3) Reading Reminders:
 - For unfinished books: Click “Continue Reading” in the “My Books” section to continue.

- For completed books: If you click “Read Again” for a second time, it will not affect your word count or reading speed.

9. Contest Rules:

(1) Before the Quiz:

- Reading Completion Requirement: Each book must be completed by at least 90% before taking the online quiz. (Reading Speed Limitation and Reading Word Count Requirement will be monitored. More details will be offered in the briefing session.)

(2) Passing the Reading Quiz:

- The reading quiz consists of 5 questions with a 15-minute duration. A score of 60 or higher is required. Each quiz can be taken only **ONCE**.

VII. Contest Awards:

Cash Prize: As illustrated in the chart below.

Certificate: Participants can accumulate self-learning hours for the 114-2 semester and obtain a participation certificate.

VIII. Rank Classification:

Rankings are based on the number of completed books. If two participants complete the same number of books, the one with the higher score and who submits first will be ranked first.
