Competition Guidelines & Process

2026 “Wenzao Cup” Let’s Speak Up! Let Your Hidden English Bloom! [Contest Rules]

Item	Description
Purpose	To encourage students of all programs at Wenzao Ursuline University of Languages to learn English through correct, effective methods, strengthen their spoken English communication skills, enhance their competitiveness in the job market, and foster a diverse English-learning environment.

Registration Period	September 7, 2026 (Mon) 9:00 AM – September 27, 2026 (Sun) 11:59 PM (21 days total)
Online Preliminary Round Period	October 1, 2026 (Thu) 9:00 AM – October 27, 2026 (Tue) 11:59 PM (21 days total)
On-site Final Period	November 18, 2026 (Wed), 3:00 PM – 5:00 PM (each session expected to last about 1 hour, with 5 teams competing per session)
Contest Category / Format	Team format. Every team consists of two members (one of whom serves as team leader).
Eligibility	• A. Currently enrolled students from any department/program at Wenzao Ursuline University of Languages. • B. The top 10 teams from the preliminary round will advance to the final.
Contest Format	Online Preliminary Round: Teams complete the contest content online at their own convenience during the preliminary period; ranking is based on the team’s combined total score. On-site Final: Teams compete at their scheduled time at the English/Foreign Language Diagnostic Counseling Center (Lourdes Building, 2F).
Preliminary Round Format	An elimination round based on each team’s combined total score from two contests: Shadowing and Read-Aloud.
Final Round Format	A ranking round based on each team’s combined total score from two contests: Shadowing and Read-Aloud.
Registration Process	Participants should follow the steps below to complete team registration and take part in the preliminary round (for details, see the “Preliminary Round Team Registration / Contest Process Guide”): STEP 1: Each team member scans the contest QR code or taps the URL to install/open and log in to MyET. STEP 2: Team Formation Process (1) Decide on a team name. (2) The team leader creates the team using the chosen team name. (3) The team leader shares the team name with all team members. (4) Team members search for the team and join it.

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	(5) The team leader reviews and approves the team members. (6) Once the team has been successfully formed, proceed with registration. Please read the Team Creation/Formation Process Guide carefully before forming your team. STEP 3: The team leader fills out the online registration form on behalf of the team and uploads all team members’ student IDs and a voice sample. Online registration form: https://reurl.cc/mzlQ3V *Each team may complete the above three steps before the preliminary round begins. * STEP 4: Once the preliminary round begins, scan the contest QR code or tap the URL, then log in to MyET with your personal account to start the contest. Contest Procedure	Preliminary Round: All team members tap the URL for each contest, log in to MyET with their personal Wenzao portal account and password, and on each contest’s introduction page (e.g., “2026 WZU Cup — WZU Let’s Speak Up! Let your hidden English bloom! 【Shadowing Contest】”) tap “Start Competition.” Teams may complete both contests an unlimited number of times during the period; ranking is based on the combined best total scores of the team’s members across both contests. Final Round: The organizer will schedule and notify advancing teams of their final-round time slot. During the scheduled time, all team members may complete the contest content only once and may not retake it. The organizer ranks teams by the sum of each member’s single best score in each contest.
Results Announcement	• A. Advancing teams will be announced on the Language Diagnostic Counseling Center website no later than October 30, 2026 (Fri). • B. Final results will be announced on the same website no later than November 20, 2026 (Fri).
Scoring Method	Scoring is conducted using the “MyET Automatic Speech Analysis System” (ASAS ©, Automatic Speech Analysis System, R.O.C. Invention Patent No. 189374). Rankings are based on each team’s combined best-score data across the four contests. In the event of a tie, teams will be ranked by their combined pronunciation, intonation, fluency, and stress scores, from highest to lowest.
Awards	Final Round Team Awards: • A. 1st Place: Certificate + NT\$2,500 scholarship per team • B. 2nd Place: Certificate + NT\$1,500 scholarship per team • C. 3rd Place: Certificate + NT\$1,000 scholarship per team • D. All other contestants will receive a certificate of participation.

Note: Any changes to the schedule will be announced on the day of the contest.

On-site Final – Important Notes

1. Contestants must bring a photo ID (such as a student ID or national ID card) for check-in and verification.
2. To ensure the on-site competition starts and ends on schedule, all contestants must check in on time.
3. The organizer will provide all contestants with the same model of headset and microphone for the on-site competition.

On-site Final – Competition Rules

1. Once the official competition begins, all contestants will enter the speaking-contest hall and compete according to their assigned group, completing the contest content within the time limit; the score is the highest score achieved within that time limit.
2. When staff announce that time is up for a round, any contestant who has not finished must stop immediately, put down their headset, and not touch the computer again. Violating this rule results in a 10-point deduction from the total score.
3. During the official competition, contestants may not talk with other contestants or teammates in a way that disrupts the competition. Violators will have 10 points deducted from that round’s total score.
4. Before and during the official competition, contestants may not do trial readings (entering practice mode or any other form of practice), leave and re-enter the competition partway through, or repeat a round after completing it. Violators will have 10 points deducted from the total score (this does not apply if the organizer determines on the spot that the issue was due to equipment malfunction, a software error message, or a network connection problem).
5. During the official competition, contestants may not use any electronic device that could affect the

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fairness of the competition, such as a mobile phone (please switch to silent mode), a recorder, or a translator device. Violators will have 10 points deducted from the total score.

6. If staff discover that a contestant is impersonating another person, that team will be disqualified regardless of whether the competition has been completed.

7. During the official competition, contestants may not open any operating-system function or application unrelated to the designated MyET software. Violators’ teams will be disqualified.

8. During the official competition, contestants may not disturb other contestants in any way (e.g., shouting, coughing loudly, or tapping on the desk to make noise). Violators’ teams will be disqualified.

9. If any contestant encounters a situation that affects the competition during the official round (e.g., computer or headset/microphone malfunction), they should stop all actions immediately and raise their hand to wait for staff assistance before resuming the competition.

10. Contestants who finish the official competition early — or once staff announce that time is up — should remain on the results page and raise their hand to wait quietly while staff verify the score recorded in the MyET system and manually record the score (total score and pronunciation score).

11. The final scores of all teams will be calculated based solely on the data recorded in MyET, supplemented by the staff’s manual score record sheet. No contestant may dispute the recorded scores after the competition has ended.

Scoring Method

1. Final scores are calculated based solely on the score data shown on the MyET platform; any rule-violation deductions are also factored in.

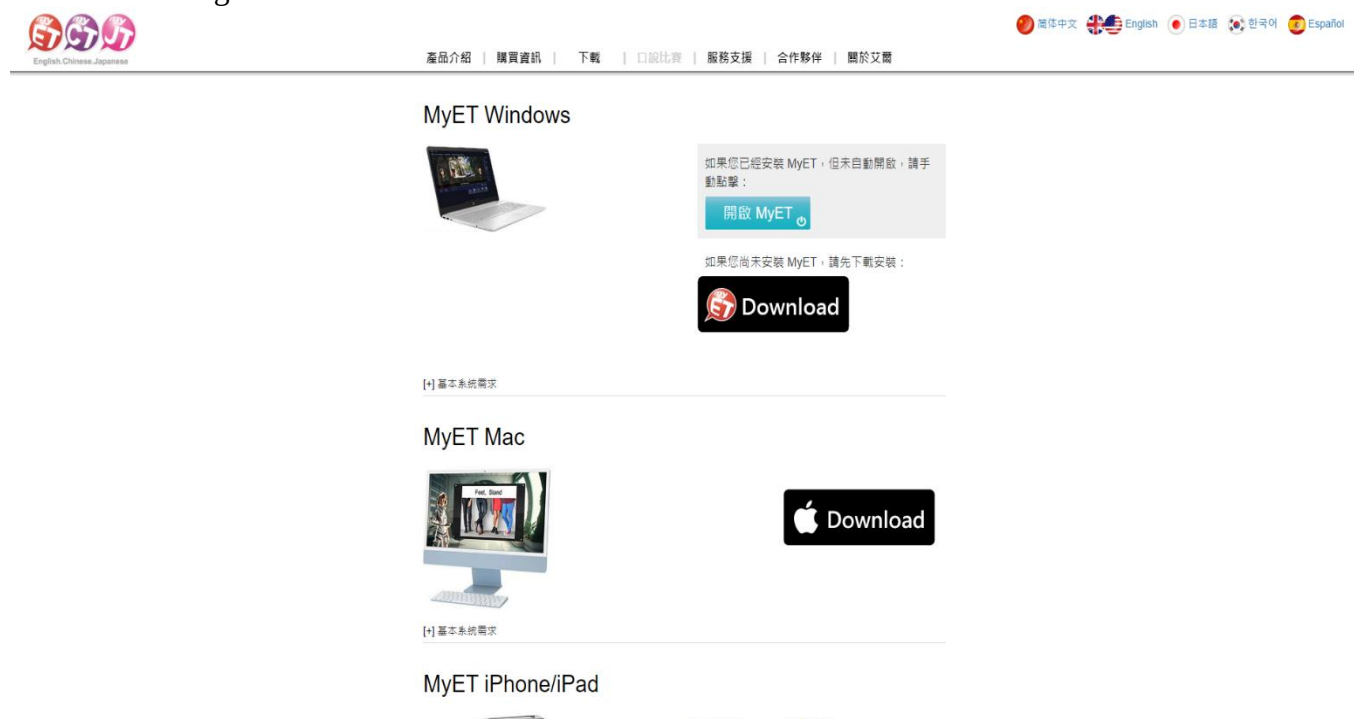
2. Each contestant’s final official competition score is calculated to two decimal places.

3. Each team’s contest score is calculated as the combined total score of all members across the two final-round contests.

4. If teams are tied on final combined total score, they will be ranked in order by the combined score of pronunciation → intonation → fluency → stress across both contests, from highest to lowest.

Team Leader's Team Creation Process Windows PC/NB, iPad, Android Pad, Mac

1. After the online preliminary round begins, team members should download and install, or open, the latest version of the MyET app already installed on the device via the dedicated link for the Shadowing Contest and Read Aloud Contest.



2. On the introduction page for the Shadowing Contest and Read Aloud Contest, team members should click “Login” in the top right corner and log in to MyET using the same account and password as the Wenzao Ursuline University of Languages information service portal.
*** Please confirm that you have correctly entered the school-specific server.**
*** Password length should be between 4-16 characters, and password characters may only include special characters such as “_”, “-”, “.”, “\$”, “!”, “^”, “~”, “<”, “>”, “;”, “@”. If your password does not meet these rules, please change it through the information service portal first.**
*** When using a public computer, before logging in, do NOT select 「Remember my account and password on this computer」**

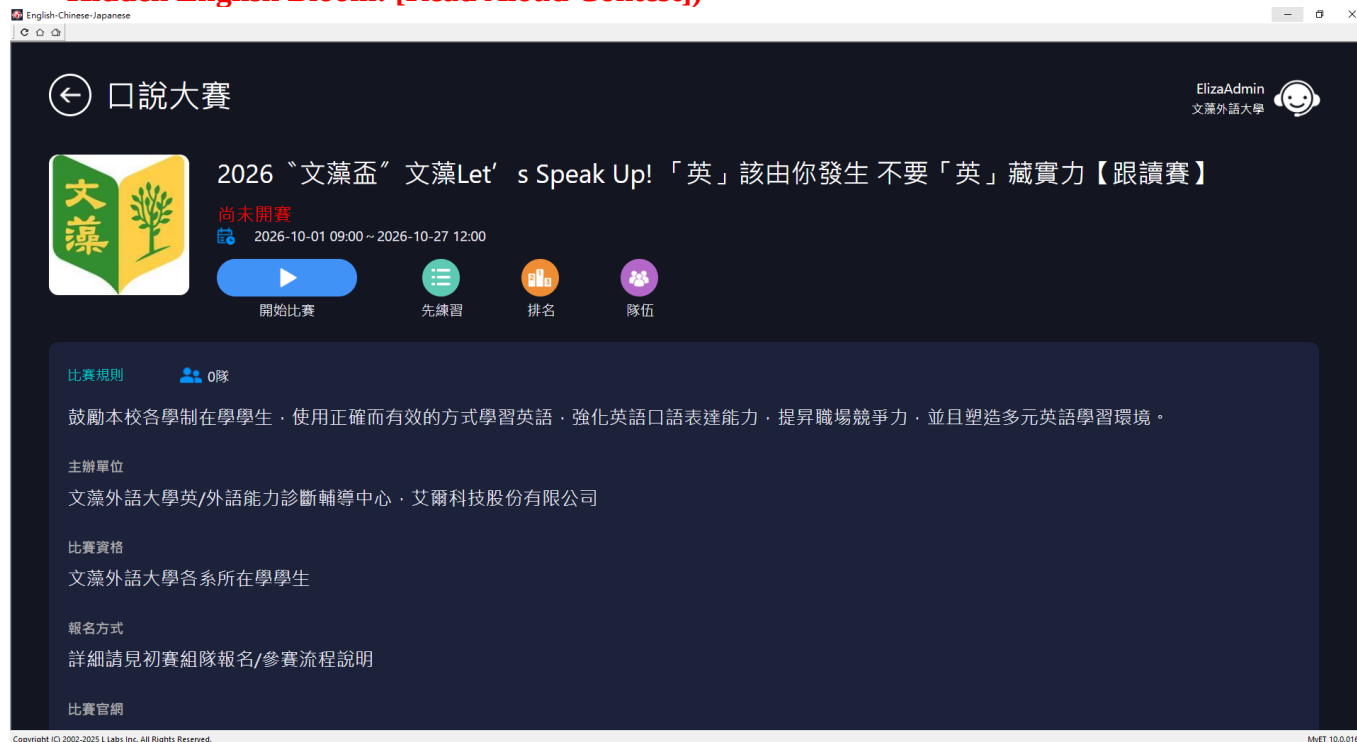


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- On the introduction page for the Shadowing Contest and Read Aloud Contest, team members should click the “Start Competition” button to take part in the Shadowing Contest and Read Aloud Contest respectively.

*** Shadowing Group Contest name: (2026 “Wenzao Cup” Wenzao Let’s Speak Up! Let Your Hidden English Bloom! [Shadowing Contest])**

*** Read Aloud Group Contest name: (2026 “Wenzao Cup” Wenzao Let’s Speak Up! Let Your Hidden English Bloom! [Read Aloud Contest])**



- The first time you enter the introduction page for the Shadowing Contest or Read Aloud Contest and click the “Start Competition” button, a screen will appear asking you to enter the contest-specific authorization code. Enter the authorization code for each of the two contests, then click “Submit” to begin the competition.

*** Shadowing Group Contest authorization code: WZU20261 (case-insensitive)**

*** Read Aloud Group Contest authorization code: WZU20262 (case-insensitive)**

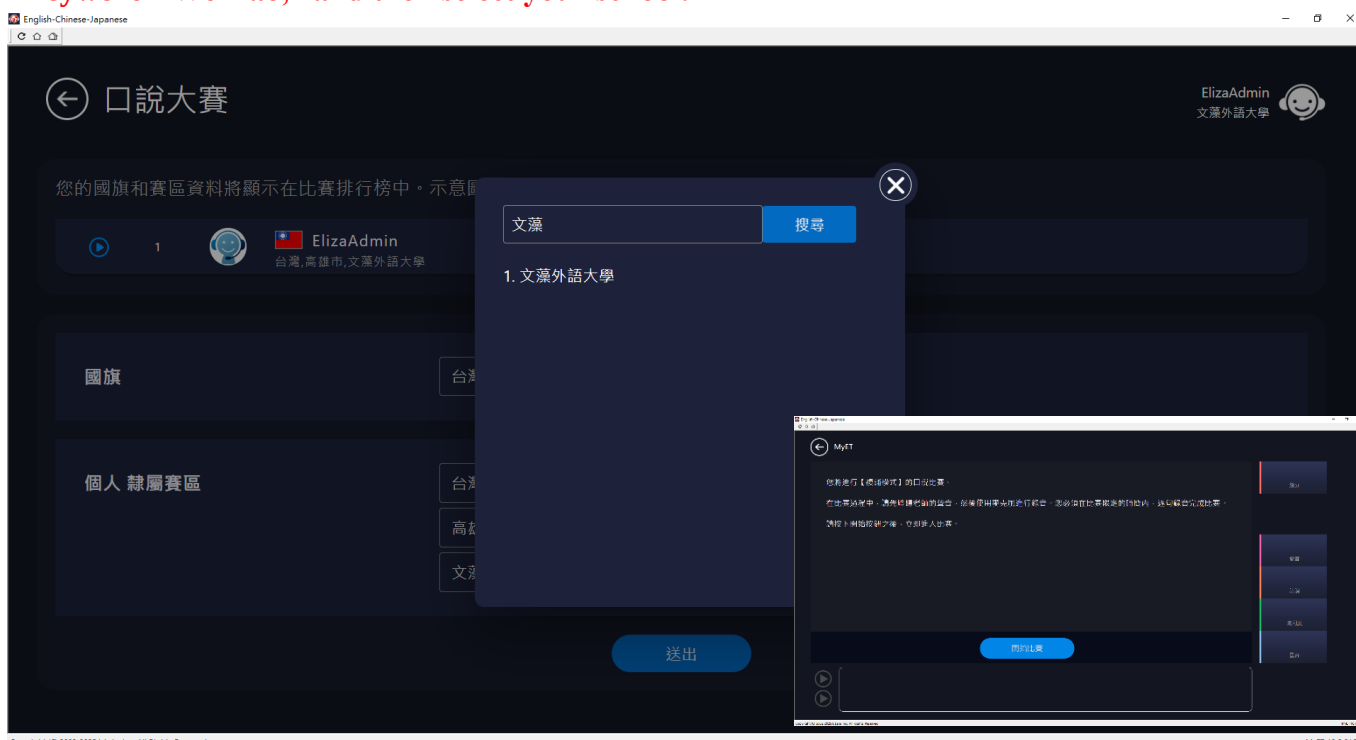
*** The authorization code only needs to be entered the first time you take the competition.**



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- Before entering the Shadowing Contest or Read Aloud Contest, if you have never taken part in any MyET competition before, please fill in the competition region according to the location of your school, and click “Submit.” The pre-competition screen for that contest will then appear.

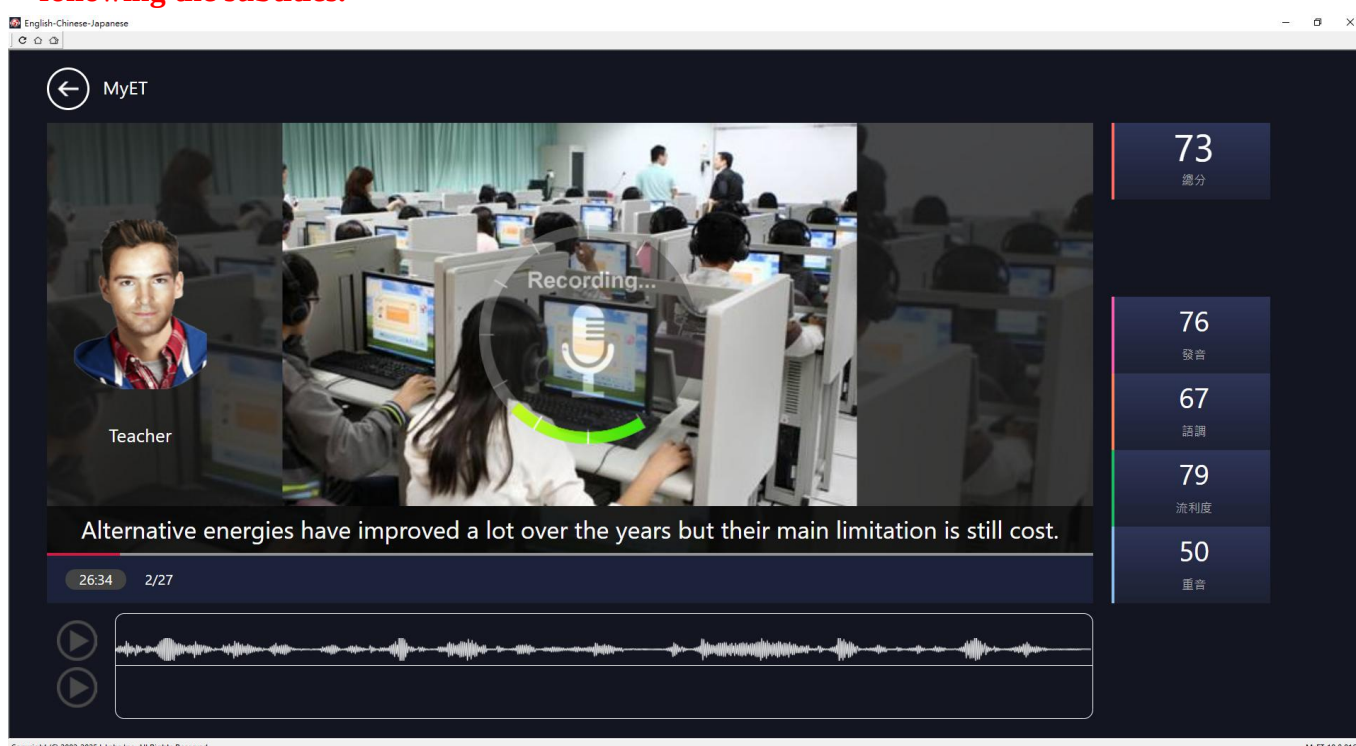
*** First select the county/city where your school is located, click the search button, enter the keyword “Wenzao,” and then select your school.**



- During the competition, whenever the “Please Record” icon appears, speak the sentence into the microphone and wait for MyET to score it. Once the sentence has been scored, MyET will automatically move on to the next sentence. During the online preliminary round, you may take the competition an unlimited number of times, anytime and anywhere, until the competition period ends. MyET will use your highest score as your result for that contest.

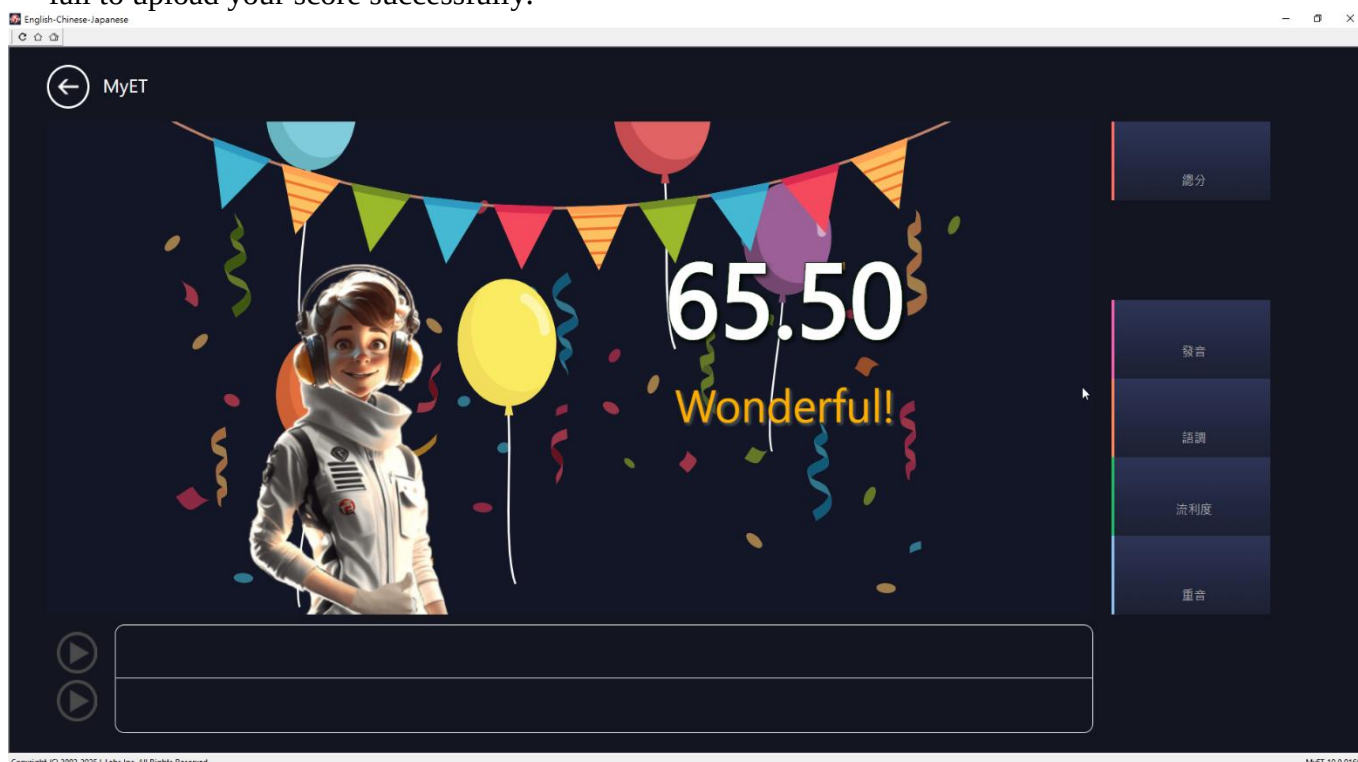
*** Shadowing mode: listen to one sentence, then say it.**

*** Read Aloud mode: listen to all the sentences first, then read them aloud one by one while following the subtitles.**

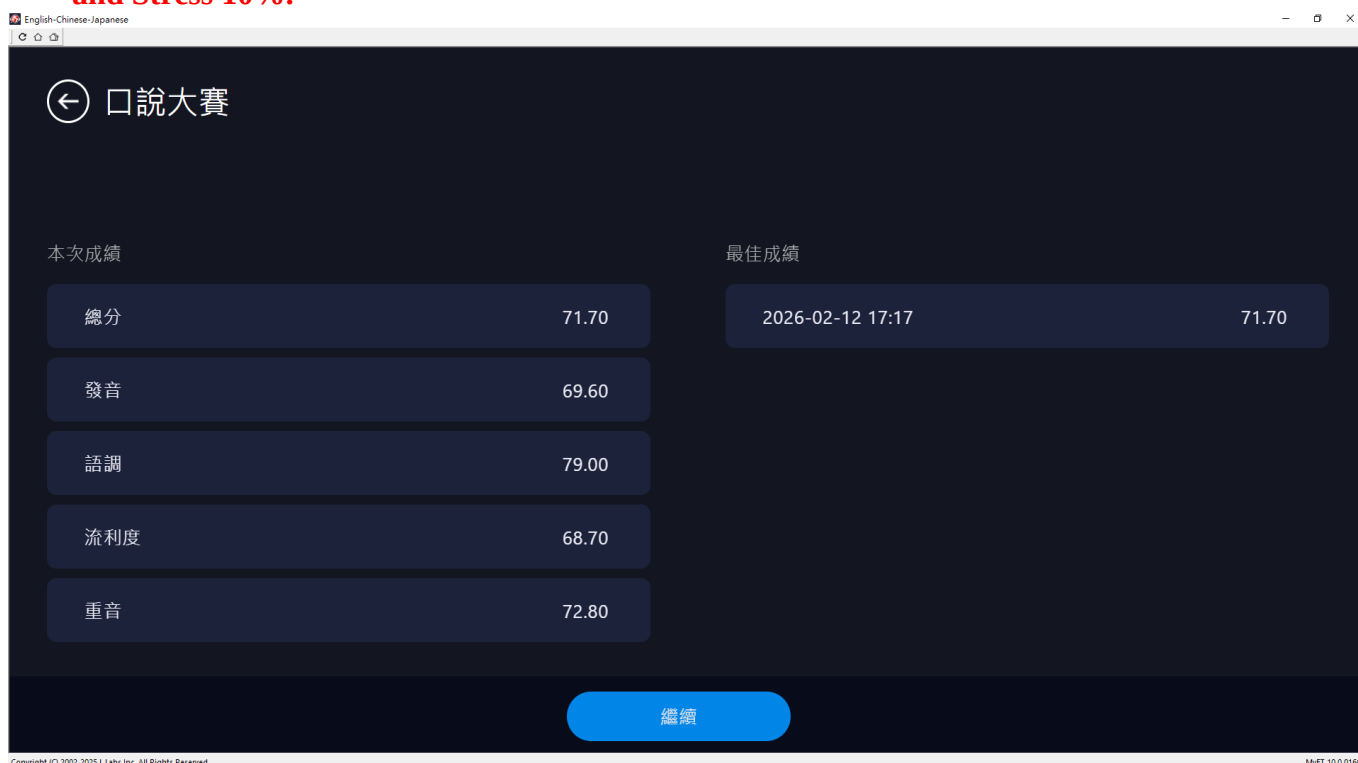


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- After completing the script content for each contest, please wait for your score to upload to the cloud. Do not close the app before the score has finished uploading and been saved to the cloud, or MyET may fail to upload your score successfully.

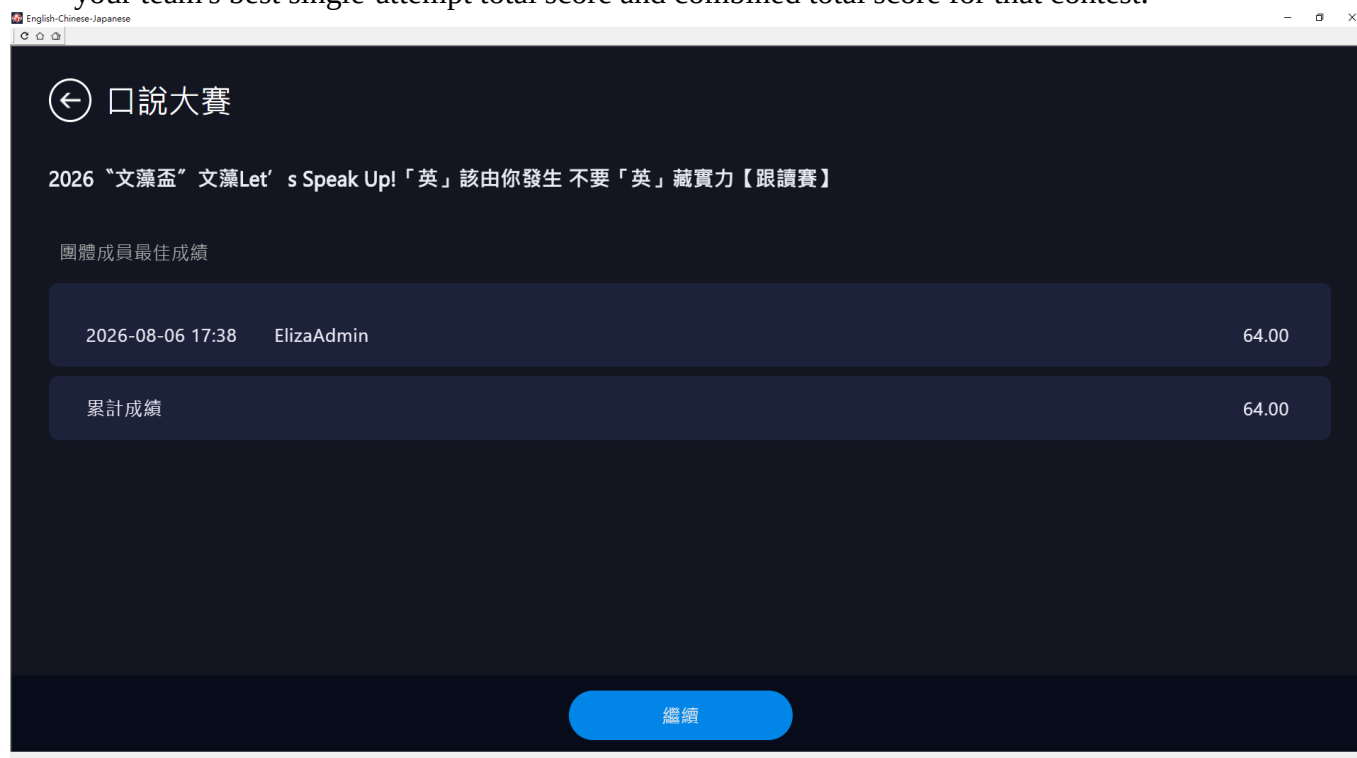


- Once your score for each contest has been uploaded to the cloud, you can view your score for that attempt as well as your best score on the results screen, along with your scores for the four categories such as pronunciation and intonation. After completing each contest, MyET will immediately display your team's best single-attempt total score and combined total score for each contest.
- * The total score for each sentence is calculated by weighting and summing the four scoring indicators according to their percentages.**
 - * The weighting of the four indicators is: Pronunciation 50%, Intonation 20%, Fluency 20%, and Stress 10%.**



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- During the online preliminary round, after completing each contest, MyET will immediately display your team's best single-attempt total score and combined total score for that contest.

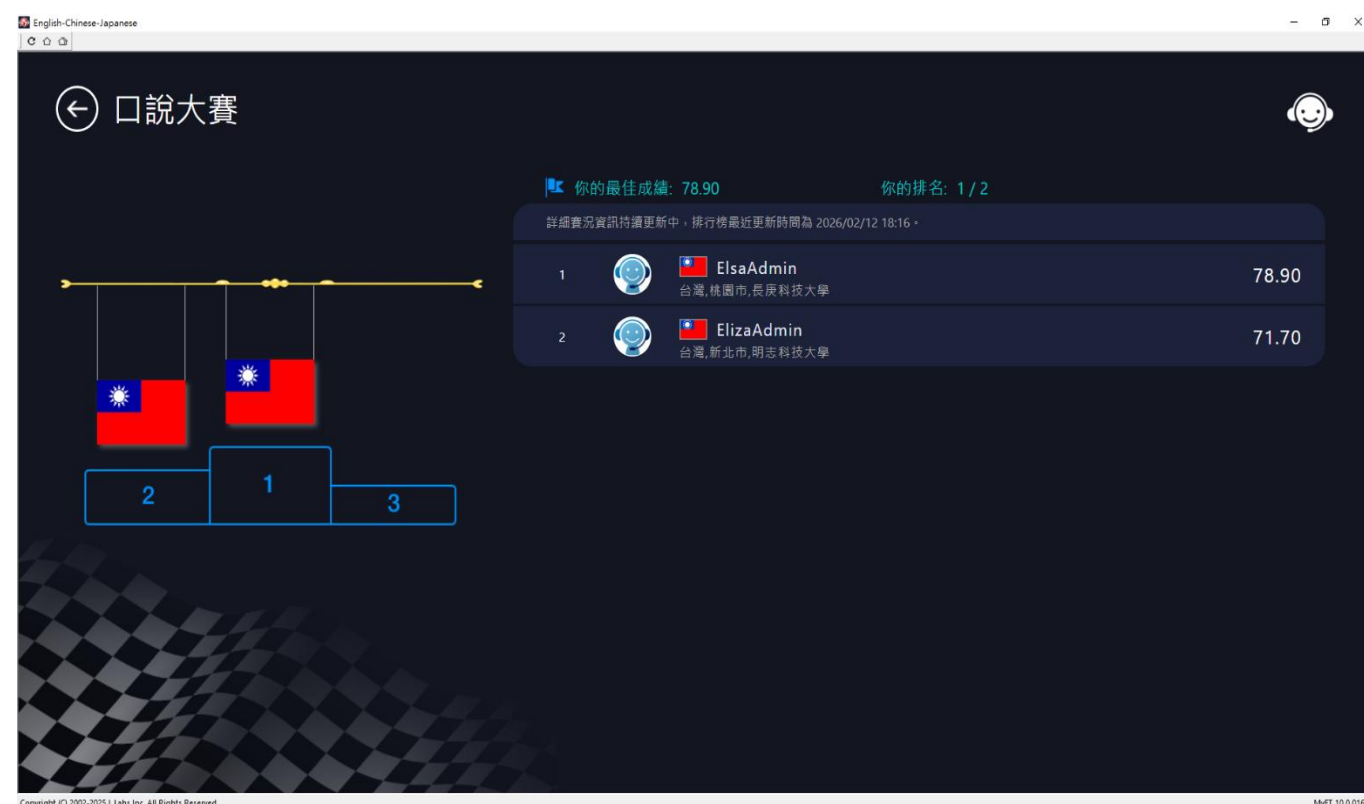

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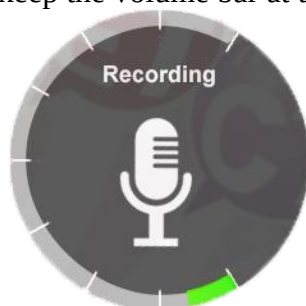
Recording Notes

* It is recommended to take the competition in a quiet environment to avoid background noise affecting your score.

* During recording, if you make a mistake, pause, or are interrupted by noise, **while MyET has not yet scored that sentence**, and you want to re-record it, always wait for the icon shown in Figure 1 to appear before you begin recording again.

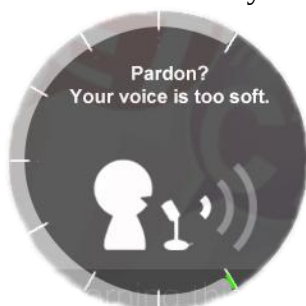
1. When MyET finishes playing the teacher's audio and the “Recording” icon appears (see Figure 1), begin recording (keep the volume level between 2.5 and 5 bars).

* Note: When not recording, keep the volume bar at the bottom between 0.5 and 1.5 bars.



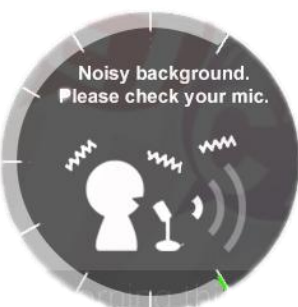

2. When the icon shown in Figure 2 appears, this means MyET has not received any sound, or the recording volume is too low for it to analyze and score. Please wait for MyET to return to the state shown in Figure 1 before recording again. (It is recommended to speak at a volume that brings the volume bar to 3-6 bars, as this makes it less likely for MyET to fail to pick up the recording.)

3. When the icon shown in Figure 3 appears, this means background noise or excessive recording volume is preventing MyET from analyzing and scoring. Please wait for MyET to return to the state shown in Figure 1 before recording again. (It is recommended to lower your recording volume or increase the distance between the microphone and your mouth to avoid interference from background noise.)

- 線上初賽開始後，參賽隊伍隊員透過跟讀賽與朗讀賽專屬 QR CODE，啟動裝置中已安裝的最新版 MyET APP



- 參賽隊伍隊長，在跟讀賽介紹頁面，點選左方“隊伍”，出現輸入帳號密碼畫面，使用個人文藻外語大學資訊服務入口網站的相同的登入帳號跟密碼，登入 MyET

***請確認是否正確進入學校專屬伺服器入口**

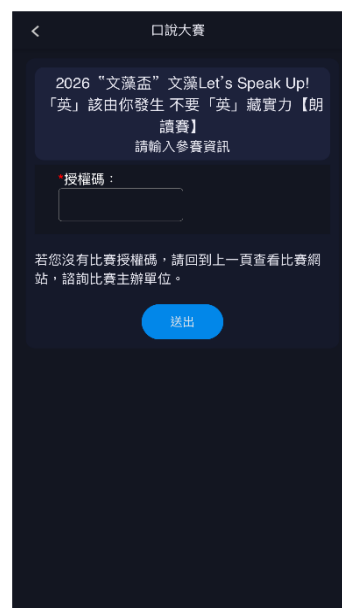

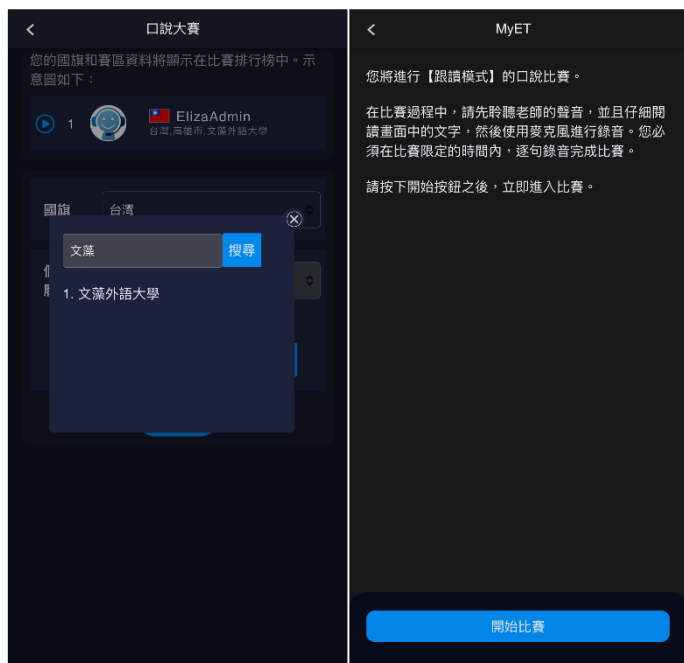

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- 在進入跟讀賽或朗讀賽內容前，若是之前從未參加過任何 MyET 競賽，請依照就讀學校所在地填寫賽區，點選「送出」，就會出現該場競賽的開始競賽前畫面
*請先選擇學校所在縣市，按下搜尋按鈕，輸入關鍵字“文藻”再來選擇學校
- 當每次每場競賽的比賽成績上傳到雲端後，可在比賽成績畫面中，查看當次該場比賽成績及最佳一次成績的分數，同時也可得知發音、語調等四項成績分數，每次完成每一場競賽之後，MyET 會立即顯示隊伍每一場比賽最佳一次總分及總分總和成績

*每一句總分依照四項指標百分比加權計算加總而成
*四項指標百分比，發音分數的 50%，語調分數的 20%，流利度分數的 20%，重音分數的 10%



- 在比賽過程中，只要看到“請錄音”圖示出現後，請對著麥克風把該句唸出來，並等待 MyET 進行評分，只要該句完成評分，MyET 會自動進入到比賽的下一句，線上初賽期間，可不限次數、隨時隨地的進行比賽，直到比賽時間結束為止，MyET 會以您最高的分數做為該場比賽的成績
*跟讀模式為(聽一句唸一句)
*朗讀模式為(聽完所有句子，看字幕一句一句唸)
- 進入跟讀賽或朗讀賽的比賽排行榜後，可以看到跟讀賽與朗讀賽，每一場競賽的 40 名參賽隊伍單場最佳總和總分成績排名。
